(Motor Vehicle Crash in Beaverton Results in Fatality; Another Transported by LifeFlight)

At 2:20 pm today, Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue crews responded to a motor vehicle collision on Murray Boulevard between Jenkins Road and One Bowerman Drive in Beaverton. When crews arrived they found a Corvette with two occupants that had travelled through a brick wall and was wrapped around a tree, trapping the driver. Two nurses who stopped at the scene and several TVF&R staff (responding from their office located at Murray Boulevard and Jenkins Road) provided CPR and first-aid to the occupants before crews arrived.

It took firefighters 30 minutes to extricate the driver from the vehicle. During that time, numerous paramedics administered advanced life support care. Due to the critical nature of his injuries, the driver was transported to OHSU via LifeFlight. Murray Boulevard was closed to traffic in both directions during the incident.

Despite the efforts of paramedics and responding bystanders, the passenger in the vehicle did not survive the crash.

A total of seven TVF&R units and two ambulances responded to the incident.
