Heavy Fire Strikes Building in Beaverton

At 6:43pm on Labor Day, TVF&R responded to reports of a fire at Pussycats on 10024 SW Canyon rd. While en route, fire crews could see a black column of smoke streaming from the location. On arrival, the initial firefighters found heavy fire billowing on the west side of the building and started a quick exterior attack of the fire. At the same time, other firefighters conducted a search of the structure. Once bulk of the fire was knocked down, firefighters then transitioned into an interior fire attack and put out all remaining hot spots.



Downed, energized power lines created a hazardous working environment, but crews were still able to knock down the bulk of the fire in 10 minutes. After a search of the structure, no one was found and no injuries were reported.

An investigator is working on scene to determine the fire cause.
