Woman Extricated from Car After Head On Crash, Toddler Protected by Car Seat

Firefighters from Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue extricated a woman from her car on Bethany Blvd. this afternoon after a head-on collision. The woman's son, a toddler who was strapped into a car seat, was uninjured. Firefighters were called to the intersection of Bethany Blvd. and Emily Ln. at 10:49 a.m. this morning. They arrived to find a head-on collision between two vehicles. They found a woman trapped in the driver's seat of her car; her young child was safely strapped into his car seat.

Firefighters from Engine 68, Engine 64 and Truck 67 set to work cutting the roof from the car in order to safely extricate the driver. Firefighters also worked to remove the toddler from the vehicle and comfort him while they cared for his mother.

The Washington County Sheriff's Office is investigating the cause of the crash.
