

Keep It Noisy!


A working smoke alarm protects you, your family, and your neighbors!






SLEEP SAFE: Smoke alarms are made to wake you and your family in the night when most fire deaths happen.



SILENT SMOKE KILLS: Most people think the sound of the fire will wake them, but it's the smoke that kills—not the fire.



NUISANCE ALARM: If your smoke alarm goes off accidentally, don't take the battery out. Fan the smoke away or open a window.



CHIRPING: When the battery is full, your smoke alarm makes a loud steady warning sound when smoke is present. When the battery is low, it makes a short chirp or beep every few minutes. When you hear the chirp, change the batteries.
